Westby Cooperative Creamery Receives Certificate of Appreciation from Wisconsin Governor.

June 30, 2017 (Westby, WI): As part of June Dairy Month celebrations, *Westby Cooperative Creamery* has been recognized and honored by Wisconsin Governor, Scott Walker, with a Certificate of Appreciation for ongoing contributions to our state dairy industry since 1903.

This State of Wisconsin award of appreciation was presented to Board Members of *Westby Cooperative Creamery* by Department of Agriculture-Trade and Consumer Protection Secretary Ben Brancel, and State Representative Lee Nerison, at a ceremony in the cooperative's offices in Westby, WI, on June 26, 2017.

The certificate recognizes the dairy farm member-owners and employees of *Westby Cooperative Creamery* for their long-term contributions to the economy of western Wisconsin and the entire state. Further, the certificate sites more than 20 awards in national and world cheese competitions for the highest quality cultured dairy food products; including cottage cheeses, sour creams, dairy dips, and yogurts.

Further recognition was stated for annual membership growth to now over 200 local family dairy farm patron-members, and sited the continuing investments in facilities and personnel to accommodate growth in product manufacturing and distribution. This track record of growth has resulted in a tripling of annual sales revenues and employees since 2004.
